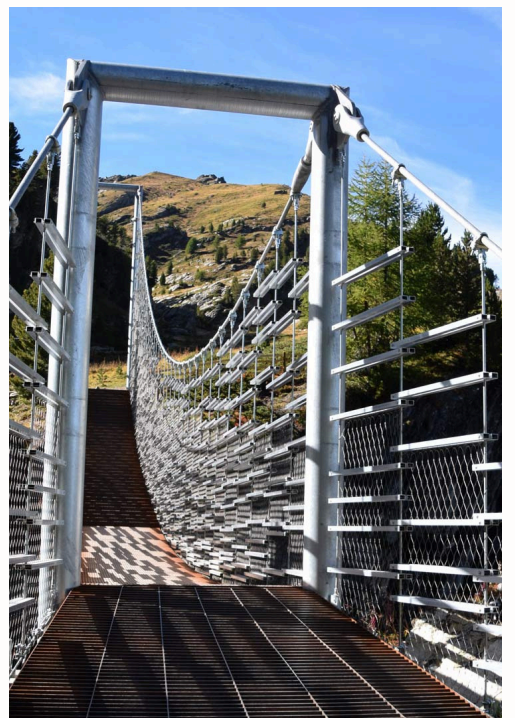
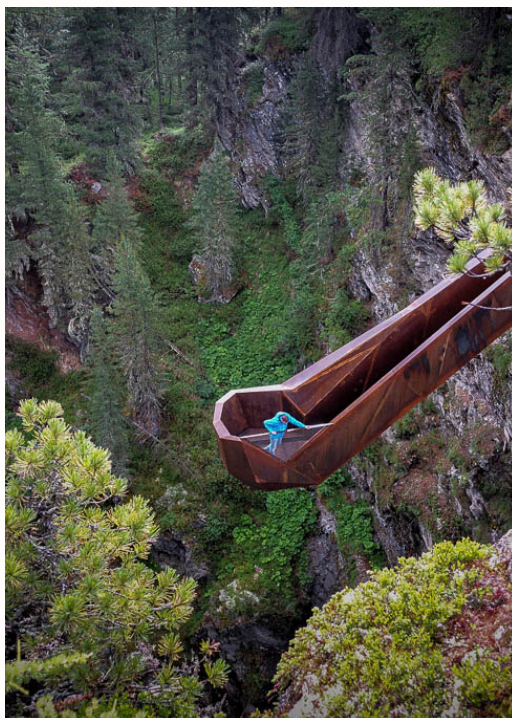


Zufallhütte

REFUGE IN MARTELL

ROUTE DESCRIPTION



The hike to the Zufallhütte starts at the end of the country road from Martell (Enzian car park). There are several ways to get to the Zufallhütte from the car park. The 'Plimaschlucht' adventure trail is the best and most interesting as you can look down into the gorge from 4 viewpoints. It leads via Marterer Talweg trail no. 36 on a pleasant ascent to the hut. You start at the end of the valley on the left-hand side and cross the bridge. You first pass the small lake and then see the former Hotel Paradies on the right-hand side. At the fork in the path, keep right and continue along path no. 36. You come to the first vantage point, the 'Kelle', which carries the visitor far down over the edge so that you come very close to the gorge with the water.

The second viewpoint, the 'Sichel', leads visitors carefully along the edge and reveals the magnificent panorama. The third vantage point, the 'Pulpit', offers a view of the Plima Gorge from above. The fourth structure at the end, the suspension bridge, offers visitors the opportunity to walk from one edge to the other, directly over the gorge. This provides a direct connection to the Zufallhütte.

After around an hour, you reach the open alpine pasture area.

STARTING POINT

Starting point: Hintermartell car park

Route: 1.7 km

Duration (there & back): 2 h

Highest point: 2264 m

Lowest point: 2065 m

Difference in altitude: 190 m

INFO

There is a small playground for children in front of the Zufallhütte. The Zufallhütte offers fresh drinks and traditional dishes. At the back of the hut you can enjoy the wonderful view of the valley!
